

For Ten Thousand, 2015 was all about releasing, touring and performing their proudly independent debut album 'First Light' (© LMG) at sold-out venues and festivals around Australia. Now the dark-edged and theatrical Melbourne five-piece are building up to release their much-anticipated follow-up album and bring their signature fusion of progressive, garage and psychedelic rock to the European underground.

Since 'Tales from the Wasteland' (© 2011 LMG), Ten Thousand have consistently delivered with confidence and grit whilst developing their spell-binding live shows, supporting an impressive list of home-grown talent such as Dead Letter Circus, The Living End, King of the North, Dallas Frasca and Massive. A MusicOz nomination culminated in the band opening The Australian Independent Music Awards while also earning a nomination in the controversial, inaugural Cherry Awards. Via the festival circuit, they've shared bills with international heavyweights Aerosmith, Van Halen, Richie Ramone and Buckcherry. They have enjoyed both national and international radio-play on commercial and independent stations. The band was featured in an Episode of the popular TV franchise 'Bondi Ink' and music from 'First Light' has been used throughout the first season of the show which has now secured distribution in over 40 countries worldwide.

If 'First Light' marked a dawning in the band's career, this year's follow-up album certainly takes the listener into a more determined, brooding twilight with influences swinging from the eclectic experimentation and conceptual dreamscapes of The Mars Volta or Radiohead; to the relentless, acid fuelled psychedelic rock of The Black Angels.
